Education

- ☛ Pupil funding - For 2005/06, this government has allocated an extra £1680 per pupil in real terms to Greenwich Local Authority since 1997/98, an increase of 43 per cent
- ☛ The number of 5,6 & 7 year olds in classes over 30 has FALLEN from 805 in 1997 to 62 by January 2005.
- ☛ 460 MORE teaching assistants than in 1997
- ☛ 750 MORE support staff than in 1997
- ☛ Primary school results - Revised figures for 2005 show that 70 per cent of eleven year olds reached the required standard in English up from 50 per cent in 1997. In Maths this number is up to 67 per cent from 51 per cent in 1997.
- ☛ Provisional figures for 2005 show that 73 per cent of eleven year olds reached the required standard in English and 68 per cent in mathematics in Greenwich LA
- ☛ GCSE - The percentage of secondary school pupils in Greenwich LA achieving 5 or more good GCSEs is up from 33 per cent in 1998 to 44 per cent in 2005 (provisional).
- ☛ In 2005 there were 5600 free part-time early education places taken up by 3 and 4 year olds in maintained, private, voluntary and independent providers.
